SOME OF THE TASKS OF A PROFESSIONAL **TRUCK DRIVER:**

- · Drives heavy vehicles;
- Monitors the state of the equipment, and the loading and unloading of cargo;
- Records information on cargo, distances travelled and fuel consumption;
- Receives and transmits information to the dispatcher and to clients.

2. MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE MINISTÈRE DE L'ÉDUCATION

· Possess a secondary school diploma (SSD) or the equivalent;

- Or Secondary IV credits in the language of instruction, second language
- Or a Diploma of Vocational Studies with Secondary IV prerequisites;

· Hold a Class 5 automobile driver's license for at least 36 months;

Not have more than 3 demerit points;

· Hold a driver's license that has not been suspended or revoked in the previous two years as a result of an accumulation of demerit points or a driving-related

• Undergo a visual test and have a medical assessment form completed by a physician.
